

State Representative Tony Dale was elected to the Texas House of Representatives in 2012. He represents southwestern Williamson County, including the communities of Cedar Park, Leander and Brushy Creek, as well as the Williamson County portion of Austin and part of Round Rock. He is Vice Chairman of the Juvenile Justice & Family Issues Committee, is a member of the Environmental Regulation Committee and is Chairman of the House Energy Caucus.

He is currently a Major in the Texas State Guard.
